

Fund Objective

The State Street Defensive Emerging Markets Equity Fund seeks to provide maximum total return, primarily through capital appreciation, by investing primarily in securities of foreign issuers.

Process

Under normal circumstances, the Fund will invest at least 80% of its assets in equity securities, equity swaps, structured equity notes, equity linked notes and depositary receipts issued by companies domiciled, or doing a substantial portion of their business, in countries determined by the Fund's management team to have a developing or emerging economy or securities market. The Fund will diversify investments across many countries (typically at least 10) in order to reduce volatility associated with specific markets. The countries in which the Fund invests will be expanded over time as the stock markets in other countries evolve. In determining securities in which to invest, the management team will evaluate the countries' economic and political climates with prospects for sustained macro and micro economic growth. The Fund's management team will take into account traditional securities valuation methods, including (but not limited to) an analysis of price in relation to assets, earnings, cash flows, projected earnings growth, inflation and interest rates. Liquidity and transaction costs will also be considered.

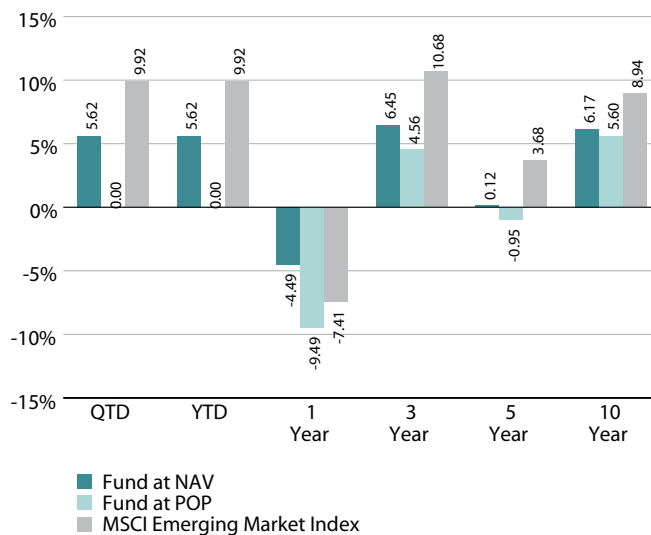

Definitions: NAV is the market value of a mutual fund's and ETFs total assets, minus liabilities, divided by the number of shares outstanding. **Price/Earnings Ratio FY1** is the closing price divided by the sum of the forecasted fiscal year earnings per share. **Price/Book Ratio** is the current market price of the stock divided by the most recent reported book value for the prior fiscal year. **Public Offering Price (POP)** is equal to a Fund's Net Asset Value plus sales charges, if any. As with the Net Asset Value, the public offering price (POP) will typically change on a day to day basis.
