

Fund Objective

The State Street Global Equity ex-U.S. Index Fund (the "Fund") seeks to provide investment results that, before fees and expenses, correspond generally to the total return performance of a broad-based index of world (ex-U.S.) equity markets over the long term.

Process

The Fund seeks to achieve its investment objective by investing substantially all of its investable assets in the Global Equity ex-U.S. Index Portfolio, which has substantially similar investment policies to the Fund. When the Fund invests in this "master-feeder" structure, the Fund's only investments are shares of the Portfolio and it participates in the investment returns achieved by the Portfolio. Under normal circumstances, at least 80% of the Fund's net assets will be invested (either on its own or as a part of a master/feeder structure) in securities comprising the MSCI ACWI ex-USA Index (the "Index") or in American Depositary Receipts or Global Depositary Receipts providing exposure to securities comprising the Index. The Fund is not managed according to traditional methods of "active" investment management, which involve the buying and selling of securities based upon economic, financial and market analysis and investment judgment. In seeking to track the performance of the Index, the Fund employs a sampling strategy, which means that the Fund is not required to purchase all of the securities represented in the Index. Instead, the Fund may purchase a subset of the securities in the Index in an effort to hold a portfolio of securities with generally the same risk and return characteristics of the Index. The number of holdings in the Fund will be based on a number of factors, including asset size of the Fund. SSGA Funds Management, Inc. (the "Adviser"), the investment adviser to the Fund, generally expects the Fund to hold fewer than the total number of securities in the Index, but reserves the right to hold as many securities as it believes necessary to achieve the Fund's investment objective.

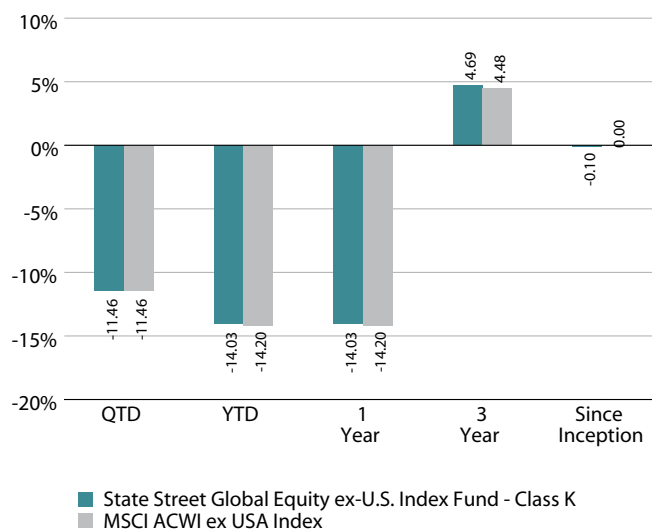
