

Fund Objective

The investment objective of the State Street Equity 500 Index Fund is to replicate as closely as possible, before expenses, the performance of the Standard & Poor's 500 Index.

Process

The Fund seeks to achieve its investment objective by investing substantially all of its investable assets in a corresponding portfolio of the State Street Equity 500 Index Portfolio (the "S&P Master Fund") that has the same investment objective as and investment policies that are substantially similar to those of the Fund. Under normal market conditions, at least 80% of its total assets will be invested (either on its own or as a part of a master/feeder structure) in stocks in the S&P® Index in proportion to their weighting in the S&P 500® Index. The Fund is not managed according to traditional methods of "active" investment management, which involve the buying and selling of securities based upon economic, financial and market analysis and investment judgment. Instead, the Fund utilizes a "passive" investment approach, attempting to replicate the investment performance of its benchmark through automated statistical analytic procedures.

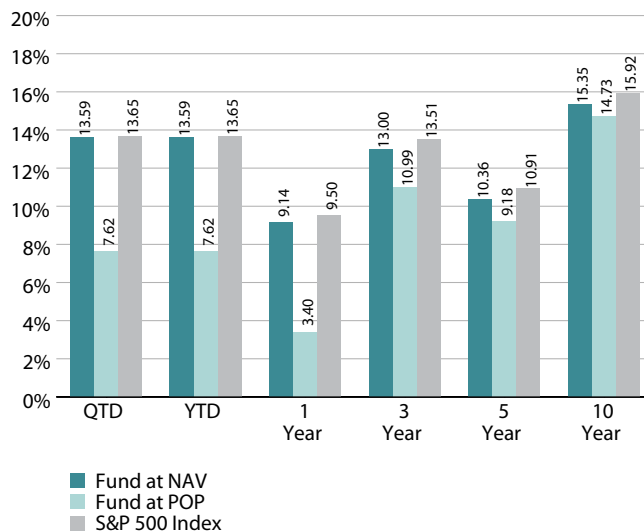

Definitions: NAV is the market value of a mutual fund's and ETFs total assets, minus liabilities, divided by the number of shares outstanding. **Price/Earnings Ratio FY1** is the closing price divided by the sum of the forecasted fiscal year earnings per share. **Price/Book Ratio** is the current market price of the stock divided by the most recently reported book value for the prior fiscal year. **Public Offering Price (POP)** is equal to a Fund's Net Asset Value plus sales charges, if any. As with the Net Asset Value, the public offering price (POP) will typically change on a day to day basis.
